JAMBOREE CLASS REGULATIONS 2023

EURO

Class Designations: EURO preceded by car number.

Do you have a EUROPEAN Car and want to give it a run down the ¼ mile at Willowbank Raceway in front of a crowd??? We are giving you the chance to make a minimum of 3 runs throughout Saturday of the Garrett Brisbane Jamboree! No wins or loses, just going for your Quickest Times! AND You can match race your mates!! ...PLUS Its Great Fun!!

How does it work?

- - Your car must be Manufactured in Europe to enter the Euro Class
- Cars running in the Euro Class (Factory Fitted with Airbags and 4 wheel disc brakes) Can run as quick as 10.00 sec
- Cars running in the Euro Class (NOT Factory Fitted with Airbags and 4 wheel disc brakes) Can run as quick as 10.50 sec

What do I need?

- Drivers Licence You must have your drivers licence with you at the event
- Helmet The minimum helmet requirement at events for street vehicles is AS/NZS 1698. Helmet Standard chart click here
- Clothing full length clothing and closed shoes.
- - All "road worthy safety requirements" must be adhered to and may be checked over by scrutineering officials.

What if my car is quicker than 10.00 seconds or 10.50 Seconds?

- The Brisbane Jamboree is run under the Rules and Regulations of the IHRA (International Hot Rodding Association) and if your vehicle is guicker than 10.00 or 10.50 seconds....
- Cars running in the Euro Class (Factory Fitted with Airbags and 4 wheel disc brakes) and can run QUICKER than 10.00 sec, you must comply with all IHRA Safety & Licence Requirements
- Cars running in the Euro Class (NOT Factory Fitted with Airbags and 4 wheel disc brakes) and can run QUICKER than 10.50 sec, you must comply with all IHRA Safety & Licence Requirements.

STREET COMPACT

Class Designations: SC preceded by car number.

Street Compact is a DYO (dial your own) Class for vehicles running 10.00 / 10.50 sec and slower, AS PER IHRA OFF STREET RULES. Depending on class size it may be broken into a number of ET brackets. Eg, 10.00 sec to 12.99 sec and 13.00 sec and slower. It is designed for full-bodied, street type cars regardless of body shape running front wheel drive, rear wheel drive or all wheel drive systems. Treaded or slick tyres permitted. The Street Compact Class is open to vehicles using a 3/4-cylinder or 5-cylinder engine or 6-cylinder OHC (over head cam) engine or 2-rotor or 3-

rotor engines. Maximum of 2 power adders permitted. Vehicles that previously raced in Street FWD, Street RWD and Street AWD and run 10.00 sec or slower will run in this class. Minimum Dial In is 10.00sec.

CLASS REGULATIONS

Engine

Engine: Production based engines only, must be in original position and configuration. Engine modifications permitted. Engine swaps permitted. Maximum 2 power adders. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Accepted engines: -

- 3/4-cylinder (push rod or over head cam) Maximum capacity 3.0 Ltr
- 5-cylinder (push rod or over head cam) Maximum capacity 3.0 Ltr
- 6-cylinder (over head cam only) Maximum capacity 4.1Ltr.
- 2-rotor or 3-rotor

Exhaust: Open exhaust permitted except where prohibited by track rules. All exhaust outlets must exit below the sill panel and be directed to the rear. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Fuel: Restricted to pump, racing petrol or methanol only. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Fuel Tank: Replacement fuel cell permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Intercooler: Permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Liquid Overflow: Required. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Nitrous Oxide: Permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Turbocharger, Supercharger: Permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Driveline

Driveline: Tail-shaft loop required on all cars running quicker than 13.00 sec. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHR

Flywheel Shield: All Manual transmission equipped vehicles running quicker than 11.00 sec must have a flywheel shield. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Transmissions: Manual or Automatic automotive transmissions permitted only. Modifications limited to what fits within the stock transmission and bell housing. Trans brake permitted. Aftermarket transmissions prohibited. Clutchless and/or sequential shifted manual transmissions prohibited, each shift must be a function of the driver and controlled manually. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Brakes and Suspension

Brakes: Four-wheel hydraulic brakes required. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Front Suspension: Aftermarket steering and suspension components permitted but must use original mounting points. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHR

Rear Suspension: Aftermarket suspension components permitted but must use original mounting points. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Wheelie Bars: Prohibited.

Body and Chassis

Body: Any automotive or light truck body permitted. OEM doors required. Lightweight bonnet, guards and boot permitted. One-piece front clip permitted only with permission from Jamboree AUS.

Chassis: OEM chassis, floor-pan and firewall required. Front or Back-half chassis, tube chassis prohibited. OEM engine location for body used required. Refer IHRA General Regulations

Wheelbase: Must retain original wheelbase of vehicle plus or minus 1 inch (25mm).

Windshield/Windows: Must have complete OEM windshield and windows as fitted by factory and be operatable by electrical or OEM mechanical means. Lexan or plexiglass windows are prohibited.

Wheels and Tyres

Tyres: Treaded or slick tyres permitted. Tyres must fit within the factory guard openings. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Wheels: Must be suitable for street or racing use. Use of temporary replacement wheels or space savers are prohibited. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Interior

Interior: Door trims, carpets, and interior trim in general is optional. Minimum of a drivers seat required. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Electrical

Batteries: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Computer: Aftermarket and piggy back computers permitted. Data loggers permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Electrical: Two headlights and taillights must be present but need not be operational except for one working taillight. One headlight assemble may be removed for air intake purposes. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Ignition: Aftermarket ignition systems permitted. Rev limiters and two steps permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Driver and Safety

Arm Restraints/Window Nets: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Fire Extinguisher System: Permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Head Protector: Required. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Helmet: Required. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHR

Licence Requirements: Civil drivers licence required as minimum. Subject to track sanction requirements. Sanctioning Body Day license may be required to purchase base on expected ET vehicle will run..

Neck Collar: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Parachute: Compulsory on all vehicles exceeding 140 mph (224 kph) Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHR

Protective Clothing: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Safety Belts: Required. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

General

Sponsor Decals: All racers must display the event and class sponsor decals on both sides of the race vehicle at all times during the event. Decals must be in a prominent location, clearly visible as required by The Jamboree AUS Pty Ltd. Failure to do so will forfeit any prize purse posted and may lead to disqualification.

Tow Vehicles: Prohibited.

Warm Up Procedure: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

ALL MOTOR

Class Designations: AM preceded by car number.

All Motor is run on a DYO (dial your own) system and is designed for full-bodied vehicles using normally aspirated engines with no power adders using a 4-cylinder or 5-cylinder engine or 6-cylinder OHC (over head cam) engine or 2-rotor or 3-rotor engine. Full tube chassis and front or back half conversions permitted.

CLASS REGULATIONS

Engine

Engine: Production based engines only, must be in original position. Engine swaps permitted. Aftermarket blocks and cylinder heads permitted. Dry-sump and crankcase evacuation systems permitted. Power adders prohibited. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Accepted engines: - 4-cylinder (push rod or OHC) Maximum capacity 3.0 Ltr

5-cylinder (push rod or OHC) Maximum capacity 3.0 Ltr 6-cylinder (over head cam only) Maximum capacity 4.0Ltr.

2-rotor or 3-rotor or 4-rotor

Exhaust: Open exhaust permitted except where prohibited by track rules. All exhaust outlets must comply with current track Sanctioning Body General Regulations

Fuel: Restricted to pump, racing petrol or methanol only. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Fuel System: Replacement fuel cell permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Liquid Overflow: Required. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Driveline

Driveline: Drive-shaft loop required on all cars running quicker than 13.00 sec. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Flywheel Shield: All Manual transmission equipped vehicles running quicker than 11.00 **sec** must have a flywheel shield. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Transmissions: Any transmission permitted. Clutch-less and/or sequential shifted manual transmissions permitted, each shift must be a function of the driver and controlled manually. Trans brakes permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Brakes and Suspension

Brakes: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Front Suspension: Aftermarket steering, and suspension components permitted. Traction devices permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Rear Suspension: FWD with factory independent rear suspension may replace with straight axle suspension. Traction devices permitted. Rear-end swaps permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Wheelie Bars: Permitted. Maximum length 65 inches (1,651mm) from rear bumper. Any adjustability during run prohibited, must be fixed during run. Hydraulics, pneumatics, electronics, etc. prohibited. Wheelie-bar wheels must spin free at the starting line before launch. Any preload prohibited.

Body and Chassis

Airfoils / Wings / Spoilers: Factory and aftermarket components permitted. Airfoils / Wings / Spoilers may NOT be wider than the widest part of the vehicle body. Any movement or adjustment during a run is prohibited.

Body: Any automotive or light truck body permitted. Lightweight body panels permitted. Must retain full-bodied appearance, with minimum 2 functional doors. One-piece front clips permitted.

Chassis: Full tube chassis and front or back-half chassis permitted but will incur weight penalty for record setting only. Bracing of front suspension towers to roll cage permitted on uni-body cars without weight penalty. Engine relocations may incur full chassis weight penalty. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Wheelbase: Must retain original wheelbase of vehicle plus or minus 1 inch (25mm).

Windshield/Windows: May be replaced with lexan or plexiglass with a minimum thickness of 3mm.

Wheels and Tyres

Tyres: Treaded or slick tyres permitted. Retreads or space saver spares prohibited. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Wheels: Must be suitable for street or racing use. Use of temporary replacement wheels or space savers are prohibited. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Interior

Interior: Door trims, carpets, and interior trim in general is optional. Minimum of a drivers seat required. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Electrical

Batteries: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Computer: Aftermarket and piggy back computers permitted. Data loggers permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Driver and Safety

Fire Extinguisher System: Permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Head Protector: Required. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Licence Requirements: Dependent on vehicle ET. Must have ANDRA or IHRA Licence if quicker than 10 sec. Subject to track sanction requirements. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Neck Collar: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Parachute: Compulsory on all vehicles exceeding 140 mph (224 kph) Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Protective Clothing: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Safety Belts: Required. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

General

Sponsor Decals: All racers must display the event and class sponsor decals on both sides of the race vehicle at all times during the event. Decals must be in a prominent location, clearly visible as required by Sport Compact Group Pty Ltd. Failure to do so will forfeit any prize purse posted and may lead to disqualification. No other event decals permitted.

Tow Vehicles: Permitted only on vehicles running quicker 11.00 sec. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Warm Up Procedure: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Record Setting

The below weights include driver and are only used for Class Record setting. Vehicles DO NOT need to meet these weights for racing in DYO Classes. To be eligible to set a All Motor Class Record, vehicles must meet the minimum weights below and all class rules. Only Qualifying, Eliminations and Final round runs can be counted towards ET/MPH records. To set a record, it must be backed up by a second run within 1%. It is the driver's responsibility to present the vehicle to the scrutineering shed immediately after a run if they feel a record has been set. Failure to do so will forfeit the record. Officials will verify weight after a run if the racer feels they have set a record for that class. The record is only awarded to that driver holding the record at the end of the event.

Minimum Weights only for Class Record setting:

Sport Compact Group reserves the right to amend weights in order to maintain parity in the class. Ballast permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

All weights include driver, verified after the run.

- 2 Rotor and 4/5 Cylinder AWD or RWD 1,950 pounds/ 884.5kgs
- 2 Rotor and 4/5 Cylinder AWD or RWD full chassis or back half cars 1,800lb / 816.5kgs
- 6 Cylinder FWD 1,950 pounds/ 884.5kgs
- 6 Cylinder FWD full chassis or front half cars 1,800lbs / 816.5kgs
- 3 Rotor and 6 Cylinder AWD or RWD 2,300 pounds/ 1043.2kgs

Sequential, clutch-less or aftermarket transmissions, add 200 pounds/ 90.7kgs. All weights include driver, verified after the run.

STREET 289

Street 289 will utilise a Heads Up with a Full Tree start and will race using a Chicago Shootout format for field sizes of 16 to 6 or elimination style for fields over 16. Street 289 is intended for street appearing production cars using standard chassis with limited rear tyre size. Engine swaps and power adders are permitted.

Class Designation: - ST, followed by driver's competition number.

Minimum weights:

- Triple Rotor / 6 cylinder (4.0 litre max) 2400lbs minimum
- Twin Rotor / 4 cylinder 2100lbs minimum

RWD cars only. No full chassis or back half cars allowed. Drag Racing Slicks with a maximum size of 28" x 9" & Drag Racing Radial tyres with a maximum size of 235/70/15 are permitted.

ET CUT OFF - 9.90sec

CLASS REGULATIONS

Engine

- 1.1 Engine: Engine swaps permitted. Any production 4, 6 cylinder or rotary engine permitted. Maximum 2 power adders. Dual stage nitrous systems or multiple superchargers/turbochargers will be counted as one power adder each.
- 1.2 Exhaust: Open exhaust permitted, except where prohibited by track rules. All open exhaust outlets must terminate below sill panel level, directing gases upward or to the rear. All turbocharged vehicles not required to use mufflers must have two 3/8 inch (10mm) bolts inserted across the diameter of the turbine outlet pipe at 90 degrees to each other, to obstruct the exit of debris in the event of a turbine failure. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations ANDRA or IHRA
- 1.3 Fuel: Ethanol: methanol or petrol only. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations ANDRA or IHRA
- 1.4 Fuel System: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations ANDRA or IHRA
- 1.5 Liquid Overflow: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations ANDRA or IHRA
- 1.6 Nitrous Oxide: Commercially available nitrous oxide permitted, including for supercharged and turbocharged engines. Nitrous bottle(s) in driver compartment must be equipped with a relief valve and vented outside of driver's compartment. Hoses from bottle(s) to solenoid must be high-pressure steel-braided. Commercially available, thermostatically controlled, blanket-type warmer accepted. Any other external heating of bottle(s) prohibited. RRefer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations ANDRA or IHRA
- 1.7 Lower Engine Containment Device: Required on all piston-engine cars using power adders quicker than 8.99 seconds (1/4 mile) / 5.70 seconds (1/8 mile). Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations ANDRA or IHRA
- 1.8 Supercharger, Turbocharger: Permitted. Maximum rotor diameter of 178mm (7 inch) for screw superchargers. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations ANDRA or IHRA

Driveline

2.1 Driveline: Driveshaft loop required on all cars. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

- 2.2 Flywheel Shield: All manual-transmission-equipped cars running quicker than 10.99 must have a flywheel shield labelled as meeting minimum SFI Spec 4.1 or 9.1. Applications for which an SFI Spec 4.1 or 9.1 flywheel shield is not available may use an SFI Spec 6.1 or 9.1 flywheel shield from another application, attached to a motor plate that is attached to the engine block at all available bolt holes, or a fabricated shield made of 1/4-inch-thick steel, surrounding the bell housing 360 degrees, extending 1 inch forward and 1 inch rearward of the rotating clutch assembly. Shield must be securely attached to frame or frame structure; may be multi-piece.
- 2.3 Transmission, Automatic: Non-original automotive transmission permitted without weight penalty. Trans brake permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations ANDRA or IHRA
- 2.4 Transmission, Manual: Any transmission permitted. Automated, timer-type, air-shifted, pneumatic, electric, electronic, hydraulic, etc. shifting mechanism prohibited; each individual shift must be a function of the driver and controlled manually. (Driver must pull the lever). Clutchless transmissions up to five forward speeds permitted in all Super Compact classes permitted to use manual transmissions.

Brakes & Suspension

- 3.1 Brakes: Four-wheel hydraulic brakes mandatory. Carbon fibre brake rotors prohibited. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations ANDRA or IHRA
- 3.2 Steering: Aftermarket steering gear permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations ANDRA or IHRA
- 3.3 Suspension, Front: Upper mounting point for strut assemblies must be in the factory location. Adjustable caster/camber pillow ball mounts are permitted. Lower control arm may be strengthened provided factory-mounting points to chassis are maintained. Lower mounting point for strut assembly may be modified for improved caster or camber. Strut tower braces, lower tie bars, sway bars, and limit straps are permitted.
- 3.4 Suspension, Rear: Control arms may be strengthened or replaced. Original suspension mounting points can be used. Suspension mounting points can be fabricated using material of the same gauge as originally fitted, as a minimum. Strut tower braces, lower tie bars, sway bars, limit straps, and camber kits permitted. Rear suspension must maintain minimum shock travel of 25mm (1 inch). All rear suspensions must use at least one working shock absorber per wheel. Traction bars/devices permitted; must be bolt on ONLY. Ladder bars and four bars permitted.
- 3.5 Wheelie Bars: May be adjustable, but must be fixed during run. Any movement or adjustment during run prohibited. Pneumatics, hydraulics, electronics, etc. prohibited. Wheelie-bar wheels must spin free at the starting line. Any preload prohibited.

Frame

- 4.1 Ballast: Permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations ANDRA or IHRA
- 4.2 Chassis: OEM chassis rails, with complete OEM floor pan and firewall must be retained with any alterations approved by Jamboree. Sub-frame alterations are also subject to Jamboree approval. Tube chassis prohibited. A maximum of two front to rear frame strengthening members, maximum 50mm x 75mm (2 x 3 inch) and fully welded where they pass through the floor, may be used to connect existing subframes. Enlarged wheel tubs to accommodate maximum 28" x 9" Drag Racing Slick Tyre or a 235/60/15 Drag Racing Radial Tyre are permitted. Rear tyres must not protrude outside the body work. Engine must be in OEM location for body used. FWD to RWD conversions prohibited. Non-OEM tubing in front of firewall prohibited except to tie shocker towers to roll cage. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations ANDRA or IHRA.
- 4.3 Ground Clearance: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations ANDRA or IHRA
- 4.4 Parachute: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations ANDRA or IHRA
- 4.5 Wheelbase: Must retain original wheelbase for body used, plus or minus 1 inch. Maximum wheelbase variation from left to right is 1 inch.

Tyres & Wheels

- 5.1 Tyres:. Drag Racing Slicks with a maximum size of 28" x 9" & Drag Racing Radial tyres with a maximum size of 235/70/15 are permitted. Cars quicker than 12.50 (1/4 mile) using independent front suspension and cross ply rear tyres are not permitted to use radial front tyres.
- 5.2 Wheels: Must be automotive-type wheels suitable for street or racing use. Minimum wheel diameter 13 inches unless originally equipped with smaller wheels and vehicle is equipped with original engine. Wheel studs must be threaded into hex portion of lug nut a distance at least equal to the diameter of the stud. Spindle mount wheels permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations ANDRA or IHRA

Interior

- 6.1 Interior: Upholstery, headliners, carpets, OEM dashboard, etc. optional. If OEM dashboard is removed, must be replaced with fabricated or aftermarket unit to provide finished appearance. Must be equipped with one seat minimum for driver, properly installed. Holes, slots, or other openings in floor and/or firewall prohibited.
- 6.2 Window Net: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations ANDRA or IHRA

Body

- 7.1 Airfoils / Wings: Single fixed rear airfoils are permitted on supercharged/turbocharged/nitrous sedans and derivates. The airfoil must be securely mounted, and may be no wider than the widest part of the vehicle body. No part of the airfoil may extend past the widest part of the vehicle body, be higher than the highest point of the roof or extend more than six inches behind the rearmost part of the body, not including bumpers or parachute packs. Maximum surface area, including all non vertical surfaces of structure, of 5484 sq cms (850 sq ins) Adjustment or movement of any aerodynamic device during a run is prohibited. One spill plate permitted on each side to a maximum of 774 sq.cms. (120 sq ins).
- 7.2 Body: Any compact sedan, derivative or light utility vehicle that has not been produced with an engine of more than six cylinders permitted. OEM body shell must be retained. Spare wheel well removal permitted; replacement material must be same gauge steel as OEM floor material. Minimum of 2 functional doors. Vehicles for which a steel, titanium or aluminium with steel/titanium liner SFI Spec 6.1, 6.2 or 6.3 flywheel shield is not available may use a SFI flywheel shield from another application bolted to a motor plate that is bolted to the engine at all available bolt holes, or use a fabricated shield made of 1/4-inch (6.3 mm) thick steel, surrounding the bellhousing 360 degrees, extending 1-inch (25mm) forward and 1-inch (25mm) rearward of the rotating clutch assembly. Shield must be securely attached to frame or frame structure; may be multi piece. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Transmission, Automatic: Trans brake permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Transmission, Manual: Any transmission permitted. Automated, timer-type, electric, electronic, hydraulic, etc. shifting mechanism permitted; Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Brakes and Suspension

Brakes: Four-wheel hydraulic brakes mandatory. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Steering: Aftermarket steering permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Suspension: All suspension must use at least one working shock absorber per wheel. Refer IHRA General Regulations

Wheelie Bars: Permitted. Maximum length 75 inches (1,905mm) from rear bumper. May be adjustable, but must be fixed during run. Any movement or adjustment during run prohibited. Pneumatics, hydraulics, electronics, etc. prohibited. Wheelie-bar wheels must spin free at the starting line. Any preload prohibited.

Frame

Ballast: Permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Chassis: Full tube chassis manatory. FWD and AWD vehicles may be converted to RWD configuration. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Ground Clearance: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Wheelbase: OEM wheelbase plus 10 inches (254mm) maximum or minus 2 inches (50mm) maximum. Maximum wheelbase 115 inches (2845mm) regardless of OEM wheelbase. Vehicles with a current Technical Inspection and Log Book at 31 December 2010 with a wheelbase exceeding the 115 inch maximum will be permitted to continue to compete until retired. Maximum wheelbase variation from left to right is 1 inch (25mm). Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Tyres and Wheels

Tyres: Racing slicks permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Wheels: Must be automotive-type wheels suitable for street or racing use. Minimum wheel diameter 13 inches (330mm). Wheel studs must be threaded into hex portion of wheel nut a distance at least equal to the diameter of the stud. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Interior

Interior: Optional. Minimum of drivers seat required. Holes, slots, or other openings in floor and/or firewall prohibited.

Body

Airfoils / Wings: Single fixed rear airfoils are permitted on supercharged/turbocharged/nitrous sedans and derivatives. The airfoil must be securely mounted, and may be no wider than the widest part of the vehicle body. No part of the airfoil may extend past the widest part of the vehicle body, be higher than the highest point of the roof or extend more than six inches behind the rearmost part of the body, not including bumpers or parachute packs. Maximum surface area, including all non vertical surfaces of structure, of 5484 sq cms (850 sq ins) Adjustment or movement of any aerodynamic device during a run is prohibited.

Spoilers: Factory fitted aerodynamic devices for the body used, fitted in the original location are acceptable. Fabricated rear spoilers must not be molded into rear deck lid. Must be painted to match paint scheme. Must be no lower than horizontal. Spill plates permitted. Roof mounted spoilers prohibited. Any adjustment or movement during a run prohibited.

Body: Any automotive or light truck body permitted. Body manufacturer must match engine manfacturer, ie. "Toyota body with Toyota engine etc". Only 2002 year of manufacture bodys or newer permitted. All bodies must be painted and in good cosmetic condition. Mild customizing permitted, but must retain full-size, full-bodied appearance and silhouette, with minimum 2 functional doors. Doors must open and close from inside and outside. Lightweight body panels permitted. Body must be full scale (7/8, 3/4 scale, etc. prohibited). Maximum front overhang 45 inches (1143mm) measured from front most part of vehicle to the centre of front axle. Vehicles with mixed engine and body combinations, that were approved to compete in FX in 2012 will be allowed to continue to compete until retired.

Street Equipment: Headlights and taillights may be painted on. Operative taillight required. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Windshield/Windows: OEM glass may be replaced with Polycarbonate or other shatterproof material, minimum thickness 1/8-inch (3.1mm).

Electrical

Batteries: Batteries must be securely mounted; may not be located in driver compartment unless sealed off per General Regulations. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Computer: Vehicle management systems prohibited. Electronic fuel injection permitted. Aftermarket and piggy back computers permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Data Recorder: Permitted. Speed sensors on any un-driven wheel prohibited. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Ignition: Any ignition system permitted. Rev limiters and two steps permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Traction Control: Not permitted.

Driver and Safety

Arm Restraints: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Driver Restraint System: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Fire Extinguisher System: Manatory. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Head Protector: Required. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Helmet: Required. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Licence Requirements: Must have track sanctioning body Licence as a minimum. Subject to track sanction requirements. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Neck Collar: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Parachute: Mandatory. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Protective Clothing: Required. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Window Net: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

General


Eligibility: To be eligibility to compete in the Factory Xtreme bracket, competitors must first become a member of the Factory Xtreme Group. An initial joining fee of \$500 is payable plus an annual advertising contribution of \$1,000 to is payable (as at 2013). The advertising contribution, is subject to review throughout the year if deemed necessary by the Factory Xtreme Group and at the AGM each year. In 2014 it is expected to be between \$1,200 and \$1,500.

Racing: Factory Xtreme will utilise a Heads Up Pro Tree start and will race using a Random Drawn Chicago Shootout Format for field sizes from 6 to 24. This may be amended depending on the number of available vehicles and the particular event schedule.

Record setting: To be eligible to set a Factory Xtreme Class Record, vehicles must meet the minimum weights and all class rules. Only Qualifying, Eliminations and Final round runs can be counted towards ET/MPH records. To set a record, it must be backed up by a second run within 1%. It is the driver's responsibility to present the vehicle to the scrutineering shed immediately after a run if they feel a record has been set. Failure to do so will forfeit the record. Officials will verify weight after a run if the racer feels they have set a record for that class. The record is only awarded to that driver holding the record at the end of the event.

Sponsor Decals: All racers must display the event and class sponsor decals (if applicable) on both sides of the race vehicle at all times during the event. Failure to display such signage may result in exclusion from participation at the event, correct placement of signage is detailed in the following image, no other placements will be deemed acceptable unless otherwise approved by the event promoter or sponsor.

Tow Vehicles: Permitted. Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA



Warm Up Procedure: Refer track Sanctioning Body General Regulations - ANDRA or IHRA

Weighing: All Factory Xtreme vehicles must report to the scales after every pass, win or loss in qualifying or racing. Failing to do so in qualifying will have the run disallowed. Racers failing to do so in racing will be disqualified.
